

Henco Industries Cookie policy

1. GENERAL

1. PHPSESSID	Functional	This session cookie is used as standard by PHP in the communication between the web server and the browser. Each visitor receives a unique and automatic identifier of PHP. We only place and use this cookie with visitors who answer a questionnaire on our website. PHP is a programming language used in the communication between your browser and the web server on which this website is published. You can not read the website without this communication.	This cookie is deleted when you close the browser.
__utma	Third party (Google)	Analytical cookie that measures visits to the (anonymous) website.	26 months after the session / update
__utmb			30 minutes after the session / update
__utmc			Close the browser
__utmt			Close the browser
__utmz			6 months after the session / update

__cfduid	Cloudflare	Used to override IP security restrictions.	Permanent
